Hold the two front tzitzis for the brachah of בָּרוּהָ שָׁאָמֵר. At the end of the brachah, before letting go of the tzitzis, pass them over the eyes and kiss them.

Saying any words—other than words of davening—is forbidden from this point until after Shmoneh Esreh on page 195. (Regarding answering amen, Kedushah and so on, see the chart on inside back cover)

> Stand and remain standing until יְהֵי כְבוֹד, on page 111. The Rebbe would say לשם יחוד quietly.

I will now daven in order to לשם יחוד קודשא unite Hashem, Who is blessed, בַּרִיךְ הוּא וּשְׁכִינָתֵה together with His Shechinah;

> in order to unite the name ליחרא שם י״ה בו״ה Yud Kay with Vav Kay.

By uniting Yud Kay and Vav Kay, I arrange בַּיְחוּרָא שָׁלִים בָּשֶׁם Hashem's name in perfect unity, and I בל ישראל: do this in the name of all B'nei Yisrael.

Blessed is Hashem Who created the world through speech; Hashem spoke, and the world came into being.
